Continually curious, infectiously enthusiastic, and unabashedly positive are how those who know Sarah Gilday describe her.

Sarah is Siebert Lutheran Foundation's Director of Philanthropy. She joined Siebert in April 2022 after holding senior roles at Sojourner Family Peace Center, Junior Achievement of Wisconsin and as a consultant serving clients in Madison and Milwaukee.

Sarah was selected by Siebert to lead Siebert Serves, an initiative to build relationships and accept gifts for the first time in the foundation's 70-year history to deepen the financial support for grantees. She brings a deep skill set for securing large gifts, building relationships with a wide range of stakeholders and growing revenue by double digits to meet aggressive revenue goals.

Sarah has a passion for helping develop talent and finding innovative approaches to fundraising challenges. Under her leadership, Siebert launched a major donor fundraising cohort for Siebert grantees. She co-leads this 12-month cohort which cultivates grantees' competence, capacity, and confidence for raising money.

Sarah enjoys volunteering, serving at church, and mentoring professionals. When she finds the time, she loves traveling to new places, a good book she can't put down, delectable meals prepared by her husband Joe and scuba diving with her daughter Eden, age 15.

The Jendusa Family

Jerry & Becky Jendusa and their five children are pillars of philanthropy in Southeast Wisconsin. They are long-time supporters of Make-A-Wish® Wisconsin and Children's Wisconsin, making a significant impact on children and families and inspiring philanthropy throughout our community.

Jerry and Becky always involve their children in their giving as they work to instill the value of philanthropy and service learning in their kids. During COVID, the Jendusas made a \$1 million gift to Make-A-Wish Wisconsin and used their gift as a match for other donors to help fill a funding gap experienced due to COVID. The Jendusas have donated more than \$1,200,000 over the past nine years to Make-A-Wish Wisconsin, equating to over 240 wishes granted.

In January 2020, the Jendusa family gave a transformational gift of \$1 million to Children's Wisconsin for mental and behavioral health initiatives over a five-year period, plus \$50,000 for pediatric cancer research through the MACC Fund Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders at Children's Wisconsin.

The Jendusas have supported fundraisers for Children's Wisconsin and Make-A-Wish Wisconsin, including an annual golf outing that for over a decade, raised over \$750,000 for Children's Wisconsin. They also support Mukwonago for Wishes, which has raised more than \$400.000.

Eaton is dedicated to transforming communities into vibrant places. With a global presence, their employees reflect their commitment to the community through their skills and ideas. Eaton's company culture is exemplified by their staff's work ethic and passion in volunteer and advocacy efforts.

They have been instrumental in supporting nonprofit organizations in Southeastern Wisconsin. Eaton team members volunteered over 33,000 hours in 2022. Since 2020, they have donated approximately \$10 million worldwide, with 75% supporting health and human services, 20% for education, and 5% for civic and cultural organizations.

Eaton has been recognized as one of CR Magazine's "100 Best Corporate Citizens" for 13 years. Eaton's dedication to corporate responsibility and community involvement is evident in their volunteerism, charitable contributions, and distinguished corporate citizenship. They leave a legacy of vibrant communities worldwide.

The oldest of three, Madilynn Puetz always lent a helping hand, especially at her younger brothers' Cub Scout meetings. When Madi had the opportunity to join the Boy Scouts of America, Scouts BSA program in 2019, she was all in.

Since joining Troop 2002, chartered out of the Bartlett Youth Foundation in Mount Pleasant, WI, Madilynn has held several leadership positions, participated in recruiting events, planned numerous campouts and was elected by her peers into the Order of the Arrow. Two years later, she is the current Chief of the Kanwa-tho Lodge. She has participated in and staffed National Youth Leadership Training and attended the National Jamboree.

Successfully raising close to \$10,000 and securing another \$4,000 in construction materials, Madilynn's vision of building an outdoor chapel for her Eagle Scout project is almost complete. The structure will be used for weddings, funerals, Vacation Bible School and other needs of her congregation.

Madilynn is enrolled in the International Baccalaureate program at Jerome I. Case High School in Racine, is a school ambassador, plays viola in the orchestra and is a member of the National Honor Society. She cantors and plays her viola at Sunday Mass and is a member of the Pastoral Council. Madi also works part time at Hometown Pharmacy. Madilynn lives at home with her mom and dad and brothers Cayden and Landon.

Philanthropic Youth of Today Award

Sean Mars earned his Bachelor's degree in Computer Science and Psychology from Carroll University with minors in Sociology and Police Science. He started his career programming software applications for multiple industries. He was a police officer for a few years and left this work to start a company and develop software for police and security professionals. This software is now used worldwide.

Sean sold his company in 2017 and now devotes his time to giving back. He volunteers as a youth sports coach and at Children's Wisconsin, where he supports kids undergoing treatment at the MACC Fund Center for Cancer and Blood Disorders. Sean also runs the Mars Family Foundation, which he started after selling his company.

The Mars Family Foundation coaches nonprofits and charities to help them run more efficiently and sustainably. The Foundation develops software, tools and programs to help charities improve their operations and increase community engagement and support.

Through his organization, Sean also created leadership programs to mentor young adults. The Foundation's building has a virtual reality room with a simulator for golf, bowling and other games, where wounded warriors, kids with disabilities and their families can have a break from their daily struggles.

Sean's philanthropic generosity to Children's Wisconsin includes a gift to advance the Mental and Behavioral Health program. He is also a presenting sponsor of the 2023 and 2024 Miracle Marathon, a long-standing annual radiothon where parents, patients and care providers share remarkable stories to help raise critical funds for Children's.


